

# Country joins WHO Thailand, MOH Malaysia and MOH Vietnam for International Health Care Week

Department of Health (DOH) Philippines OIC Assistant Secretary and Spokesperson Dr. Albert Domingo, representing Secretary Teodoro Herbosa, joined an international panel discussion on Universal Health Cover-

age, digital health, and the patient experience held on July 10, 2024 during International Healthcare Week in Bangkok, Thailand. Asec. Domingo joining him were WHO Representative to Thailand Dr. Jos Vandelaer, Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia

Senior Deputy Director Dr. Davis Johnraj, and MOH Viet Nam Director Assoc Prof Luong Ngoc Khue. Asec. Domingo shared to an international audience the Philippine efforts to improve primary health care service delivery closest to families and communities. He discussed how the Bagong Urgent Care and Ambulatory Services (BUCAS) centers, Bagong Pilipinas Mobile Clinics, and Puro-Kalusugan program are expanding access to quality healthcare in the Philippines.

Earlier in the same day, Asec. Domingo and Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Director General Dr. Samuel

Zacate joined Dr. Thanakrit Chit-Areerat, Vice Minister for Public Health of Thailand and other dignitaries as they formally opened the convention that brings together 350 health technology companies and brands from 28 countries all under one roof. “President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. is keen on bringing top of the line and value-for-money healthcare innovations and technology for our

people. His orders to Secretary Teodoro Herbosa include modernization of our health system to give the best for the poorest,” said Asec. Domingo. “Our updates on the Philippines’ focus on primary health care as the foundation of UHC got many in the convention interested in helping out. ## PH shows signs of strong investment growth

Despite global economic uncertainties, the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) today highlighted a significant 36% increase in investments approved by the Board of Investments (BOI) for the first half of 2024 relative to the same period last year. Although a 37% drop in net Foreign Direct

Investment (FDI) inflow was reported in April by the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP), the DTI remains optimistic given the buildup in the investment pipeline. “The April decline in FDI is viewed as a temporary setback, primarily influenced by global economic headwinds,” stated DTI Secretary Fred Pascual. “Our confidence in the Philippine economy remains unshaken, supported by a 19% increase in FDI over the first four months of the year compared to last year. We are also banking on the investment pipeline built from the BOI’s high level of foreign investment approvals.”

Renewable energy investments significantly dominate the investment landscape, with the Electricity, Gas, Steam, and Air Conditioning Supply sector drawing 96.3 % of the total approved investments. Among these was a PHP 297 billion investment (Turn to page 4)

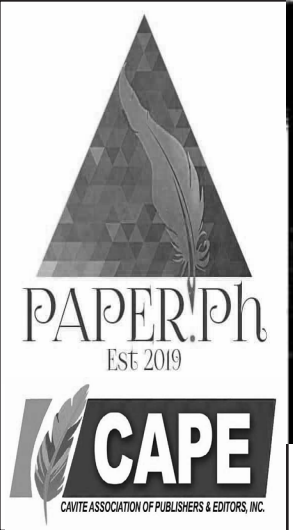

During the program, the President personally hands over financial aid to the Provincial

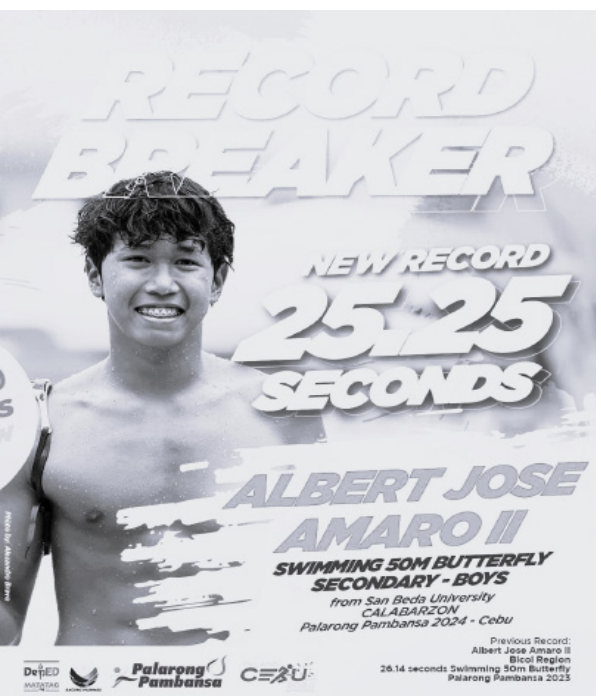

Cybersecurity, digital transformation among DSWD’s top priorities

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) puts a premium in strengthening cybersecurity and in adopting innovative and transformative approaches to better serve the Filipino people, an agency official said on Thursday (June 11).

“Priority ni Secretary Rex Gatchalian ang cybersecurity at lagi nating binabanggit sa kanya, ‘Sir it is a matter of when hindi sya if’. Kaya ganon din tayo ka-vigilant at ka-aggressive doon sa paglalagay natin ng mga mekanismo para protektahan ang sistema natin. And tuloy-tuloy yan, hindi yung pag nilagay mo na ay nandyan na at kampante ka na. Tuloy-tuloy yan binabantayan 24/7 at marami tayong tao na nakakalat sa Pilipinas na naghahalinhinan para bantayan,” DSWD Chief Information Officer (CIO) Asst. Secretary Julius Exequel Gorospe told reporters at the DSWD’s Thursday Media Forum.

(The Secretary’s priority is cybersecurity, and we always emphasize to him, “Sir, it is a matter of when not if.” That’s why we are equally vigilant and aggressive in implementing mechanisms to protect our systems. It’s continuous; it’s not just about setting it up and feeling secure afterwards, it’s a constant monitoring, 24/7, with many personnel deployed across the Philippines to keep watch.)

Asst. Sec. Gorospe said the DSWD also recognizes the importance of robust data protection in the delivery of social protection programs and services. “Hindi sya nang-yari, napigilan natin yon (hacking attempt) dahil sa magaling na pagbabantay ng mga tao natin at yung support din ng leadership ng DSWD na protektahan yung mga data ng ating beneficiaries,” CIO Gorospe said.

(It didn’t happen because we prevented it (hacking attempt) due to vigilant monitoring of our personnel and support from the DSWD leadership in protecting the data of our beneficiaries.)

In the agency’s digital transformation efforts, CIO Gorospe presented the innovative solutions being done by the DSWD in its disaster response operations, profiling of families and individuals in street situations (FISS), and in the delivery of other programs and services.

“Ang kaibahan ng Disaster Response Command Center (DRCC) sa ibang command center na makikita nyo sa iba ahensya ng gobyerno, dito makikita mo yung mga gulo o accident incidents na nangyayari and at the same time, sa kabila naman, nakikita nyo yung stockpile natin,” Asst. Sec. Gorospe pointed out.

The DSWD has also deployed Mobile Command Centers (MCC) across its field offices that feature state-of-the-art information and communications Technology (ICT) equipment that will enable near real-time coordination and communication among national and local government agencies.

Using a tablet-based profiling app, the DSWD’s Oplan Pag-Abot undertakes profiling activities for FISS to update a client’s information in real-time from a remote location.

The e-profiling tool which is part of the agency’s digital transformation efforts aims to expedite the overall reach-out operations of the Pag-Abot Program teams.

The CIO said the DSWD has partnered with different private agencies, including online payment portals, to digitize the payout systems of its programs and services.

“Dahil don sa ginagawa nating digital transformation ngayon,

dapat ang mga benepis-yaryo namin ay pwede nang mamili paano at ano ba yung pinakamagandang paraan para matanggap

nila ang benepisyo,” CIO Gorospe said.

(Because of the ongoing digital transformation, our beneficiaries

should now have the option to choose how and in what manner they receive their benefits.)
